**Core 44 College Transfer Pathway - See your school counselor for more information and to apply.**

To be eligible for enrollment in the College Transfer Pathway, a high school student must meet the following criteria:

1. Be a high school junior or senior;
2. Have a weighted GPA of 3.0 or higher on high school courses;
3. Demonstrate college readiness on an assessment or placement test in English, reading, and mathematics for enrollment in a Core 44 College Transfer Program; and
4. Meet all course prerequisite requirements.
5. Select course(s) solely from one of the four career pathways in any given semester.

To maintain eligibility for continued enrollment, a student must:

1. Continue to make progress toward high school graduation, and
2. Maintain a 2.0 GPA in college coursework after completing two courses.

**Career Technical Education Pathway - See your school counselor for more information and to apply.**

Students may take Career Technical Education Pathway Courses alone or in addition to College Transfer Courses. Career Technical Education Pathway Courses do not receive a weighted quality point, but do receive high school credit, as well as college hours as listed in course descriptions on pages 62-63.

To be eligible for enrollment in the Career Technical Education Course Pathway, a high school student must meet the following criteria:

1. Be a high school junior or senior;
2. Have a weighted GPA of 3.0 or higher on high school courses OR recommendation of the high school principal;
3. Demonstrate college readiness on an assessment or placement test in English, reading, and mathematics for enrollment in a Core 44 College Transfer Program; and
4. Meet all course prerequisite requirements.

To maintain eligibility for continued enrollment, a student must:

1. Continue to make progress toward high school graduation, and
2. Maintain a 2.0 GPA in college coursework after completing two courses.
