

2021 SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

- 1. 4 YEAR, \$3400, \$700, first year, \$800 the second year, \$900 the third year and \$1,000 the fourth year. Open to one senior student at Cape Hatteras Secondary School for continuing education at an accredited Institution of Higher Learning.
- 2. Preference is given to students planning a return to Dare, Hyde County following the completion of their education.
- 3. The award is based on:
- A. Financial need
- B. Scholastic standing, (2.7 GPA or higher)
- C. Community and Scholastic Achievements
- D. Support of NCBBA Mission Statement.

"The North Carolina Beach Buggy Association is a non-profit organization established in 1964, dedicated to the preservation of and vehicular access to the natural beach resources of the Outer Banks through conservation, a code of ethics for beach behavior and support of local, state, federal officials and other organizations dedicated to these same goals."

- 5. To apply, STUDENTS MUST submit a letter to their Guidance Counselor/ Scholarship Committee, by APRIL 29, 2021, outlining:
- A. Future Plans
- B. Financial Need
- C. Community and Scholastic Achievements
- D. Support of the NCBBA Mission Statement.
- 6. This scholarship is renewable. STUDENTS MUST:
- A. Renew with NCBBA Scholarship Director Pam Smith by 12/31 of the current school year. No renewals will be paid after 12/31 without exception.
- B. Maintain and provide proof of 2.7 GPA or higher while continuing their education with the renewal notice.
- 7. Scholarship renewal payments are made to the respective Institution of Higher Learning, in the student's name, after the renewal request, and a transcript is sent to NCBBA Scholarship Director Pam Smith at Pam.Smith@NCBBA.org.
- 8. Payment for the 1st year award winners will be made at the Annual Meeting of the corresponding

year. For renewing members: a \$500 check will be sent to the home of record made out to the institution with the name of the winner on the memo line of the check. Home address, telephone number, SSN and email address (if applicable) of the winner are required for payment.

- 9. Final decision on scholarship winners are made by the Scholarship Committees based on the criteria above.
- 10. Guidance Counselor/Scholarship Committee must forward the name of the new scholarship winners to NCBBA Scholarship Chairman with their submission letter 2 weeks prior to the NCBBA Annual Meeting. An NCBBA Director or Member will attend the school award ceremony and present the certificate of award.

Award winners must attend the NCBBA Annual Meeting for presentation of the Scholarship award certificate and Scholarship check. Publicity photos will be taken prior to the Annual Meeting.

The Annual Meeting is held each year on Memorial Day Saturday at the Rodanthe-Waves-Salvo Community center at 1 pm. The winner and their parents are requested to attend as our guests to attend the Pig Pick and entertainment that follows the meeting.
